ADMISSION POLICY

Admissions are granted by the college admission committee on the basis of merit in their respective category and according to seat reserved by the Directorate FGEIs and affiliated universities.

Application for admission in the college must be made on prescribed form attached with prospectus which is available in the college office, Prospectus can be purchased on payment. Filled application forms along with relevant documents mentioned on the back of the admission form must be submitted to college office within due date. Admission schedule is announced after the declaration of Matric result by F.BISE, Islamabad Multan board.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADMISSION

1. Admission Forms / Prospectus can be taken from college office during working hours.
2. No admission form will be issued / received after due date.
3. The candidate will have to submit admission forms complete in all respects within due date.
4. Incomplete forms / documents will not be entertained.
5. The photocopy of the admission form will not be acceptable.
6. The age limit for admission in first year class is 15 to 19 years.
7. The admission forms bearing incorrect particulars and fake attestation / signature will be considered rejected.
8. The admission forms must be submitted to college office in proper file cover.
9. A candidate desirous of applying for more than one group, will have to submit separate forms for each group within the stipulated period.
10. The final list of selected candidates will be displayed on the college notice board.
11. The selected candidate will have to deposit their dues on announced date. Otherwise his selection will be cancelled and the seat will be offered to the next waiting candidate.
12. The selected candidate will have to appear before the admission committee for interview on given date and time. The selected students are directed to come for interview in proper dress, accompanied by their guardians along with original documents.
13. Admission may be cancelled at any stage of the session if the selected candidate is found guilty of having produced wrong particulars.
14. All admissions are provisional subject to the approval of registration from FBISE Islamabad / BZ University Multan.

15. Admission in Class XI / XII on transfer basis from Board to Board or Institution to Institution will be made within 10 days of the withdrawal from previous institution, subject to eligibility determined by the Board. The Children of Armed forced personnel & FEGIs employees will be entertained throughout the year according to the transfer / migration rules.
16. O'level student will be granted admission subject to production of equivalence certificate issued by the IBCC, Islamabad, Pakistan. However, no such admission will be made after the last date of submission of admission form with normal fee.
17. The students who do not deposit college fee / dues in given schedule will not be allowed to attend the classes.

TRANSFER / MIGRATION RULES

1. Migration cases of local / provincial colleges are entertained, if they fulfill admission criteria / merit of this college.
2. Migration cases are entertained on posting / transfer of wards of Armed Forces, Civilians paid out of defense estimates and FGEI's (C / G) employees.

SCHEDULE OF FEE / FUNDS & OTHER CHARGES

1. College fee / funds are collected for the complete year in accordance with the Government rules and regulations.
2. At the time of 1st year, admission fee and funds are payable for period of six months from May to October.
3. Fee and funds are to be paid on or before the due date notified by the Principal.
4. Fee once paid will not be refunded in any case.

COLLEGE UNIFORM

All students will come to college in proper uniform. The uniform scheme is as under:

Disciplinary Rules & Regulations

All the students are advised to observe the college rules & regulations. Violation of rules may render a student liable to suspension / expulsion from the college. The rules are as under:

1. Students are expected to exhibit nice behavior. Threatening / pressurizing directly or indirectly on the part of a student, or of his parents / guardians to teaching / non-teaching staff will be deemed as a serious offence which may lead to expulsion of the students from the college.
2. Every member of staff has the right to check the students who are not observing the rules.
3. All the students must reach the college well in time with proper uniform and identity card.
4. The students must keep their bicycles, motorcycles / helmet or any other vehicles properly locked at the parking stand. Any student damaging any bike / motor bike / car will be dealt severely.
5. All the students must behave in the college premises.
6. Students are advised to take care of their books / bags and ensure cleanliness of their class rooms and lobbies etc. The peels of fruits and wrappers of edibles will not be allowed to spread openly. Destruction or damage to the building, labs equipments or any other property of the college will be deemed as a serious offence. No student is allowed to paste notices, posters, party invitation cards, play cards, hand bills, pictures etc on the notice board / white board / walls / doors / windows without prior permissions of the principal.
7. No students are allowed to collect donation and financial contribution or conduct religious, social and political functions in the college campus without permission of the principal. Class boycott, strikes, demonstrations, raising slogans in the college, provincial, religious, political, sectarian and lingual bigotry are strictly prohibited.

8. Strict action may be executed against the students involved in fighting or inciting their supporters for fight. Immoral and criminal activities, possessing weapons of all kinds, smoking and use of narcotics is prohibited.
9. Complains if any are to be lodged with the principal through application. Any student passing immoral and abusive remarks on his class fellows, calling names and corrupting their names, dodging / bluffing the college authorities and concealing the required particulars/information will be duly punished.
10. Students are not allowed to bring smart mobile phone, camera, laptop, etc. in the college campus.
11. Students are not allowed to go outside the college during college hours. After the academic hours, students are not allowed to stay in the college premises.
12. A student may be dropped out form the college roll on the following basis.
 - Failing in payment of fee on announced date.
 - Irregularity in attendance despite the repeated warnings.
 - Committing serious blunders.
 - Misbehavior.

ATTENDANCE / LEAVE RULES

1. Attendance / Leave is recorded by the subject teachers in the classroom on daily basis.
2. According to the rules and regulations of FBISE Islamabad & BZ University Multan if a student does not attend 75% of the lectures in each subject, his admission form will not be forwarded for examination to Board / University.
3. An application for leave countersigned by parents / guardians must be addressed to the principal and should be sanctioned before availing the leave. Leave without application will be considered absence.
4. No leave application will be accepted during internal exams / test.
5. A medical certificate duly signed by a doctor of Govt. Hospital / dispensary must be attached with application for leave for more than three days on medical ground.
6. In case of leave / short leave the specific purpose or urgent piece of work must be mentioned in application otherwise leave will not be sanctioned.
7. The absence from any lecture will be considered absence for the full day.
8. If a student absents himself from college for consecutive 6 days, his name will be stuck off from the college.
9. Leave for more than three days will be granted only in extreme emergency.
